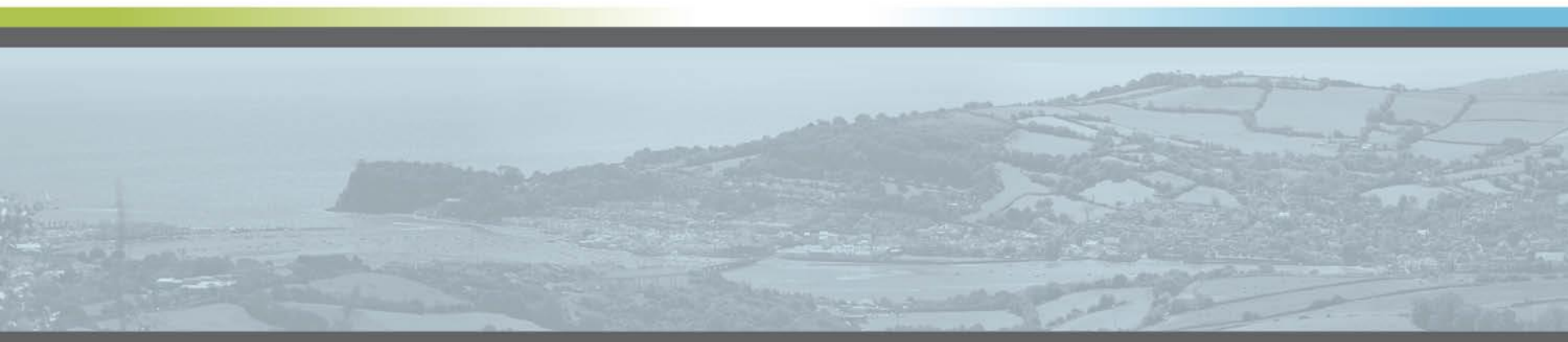

From Objectives to Policies



- Set requirements for new development
- Inform and guide planning decisions
- Carry significant legal weight
- Must comply with national and local planning policy
- Clearly address objectives
- Result in the desired outcome

Policies should be ...

- Be written in plain English
- Avoid duplication
- Avoid ambiguity
- Stem from your vision and help deliver at least one of your objectives
- Be grouped in Topics
- Stand out visually
- Be evidence-based
- Address a local challenge
- Be positive
- Be deliverable

<i>Example 1: Protect and enhance all green spaces within the Parish</i>	BTNDP1: Protection of green spaces within the neighbourhood – development that may result in the loss of green spaces or that results in any harm to their character setting, accessibility or appearance, general quality or to amenity value will only be permitted if the community would gain equivalent benefit from provision of a suitable replacement.
