Bovey Tracey is a beautiful and welcoming market town with winding streets and picturesque parks.

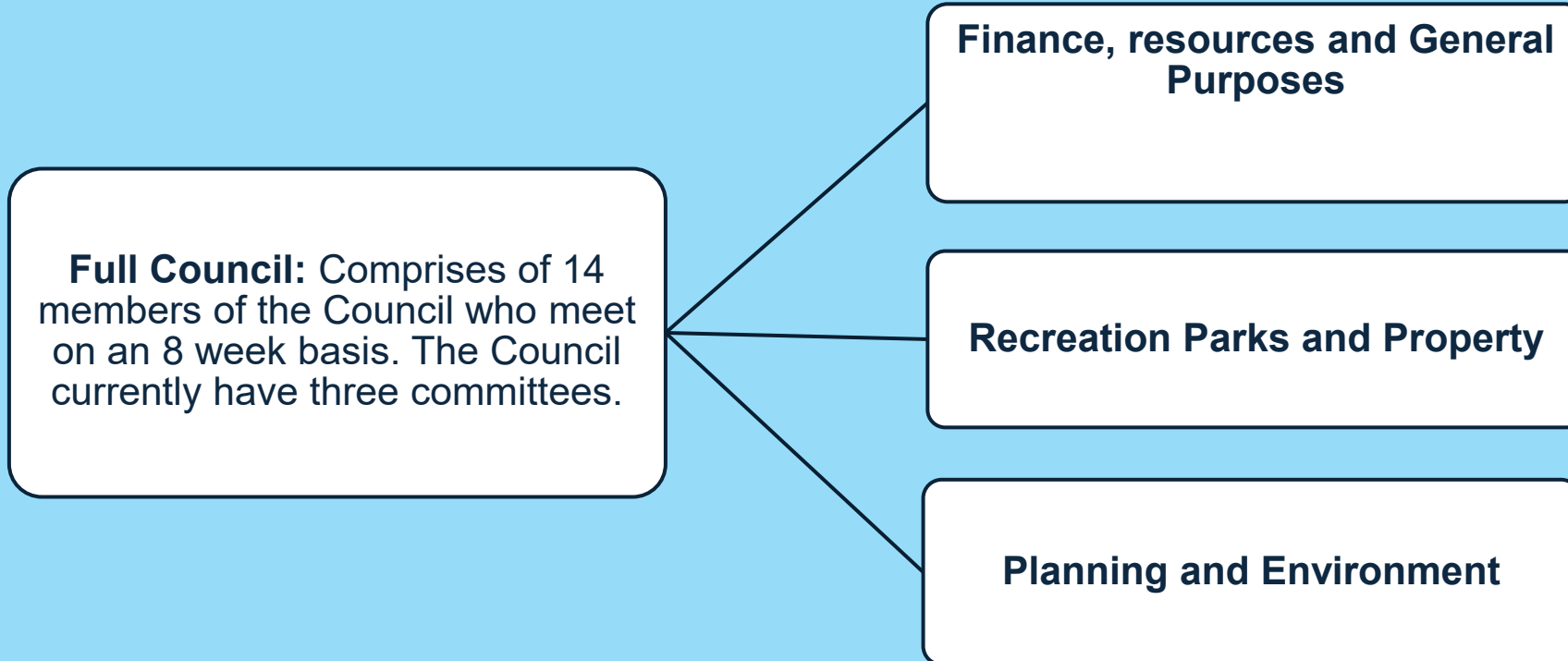
Bovey Tracey Parish Council was formed in 1896 after the largest reshuffle of local government for many years and in 1974 became Bovey Tracey Town Council.

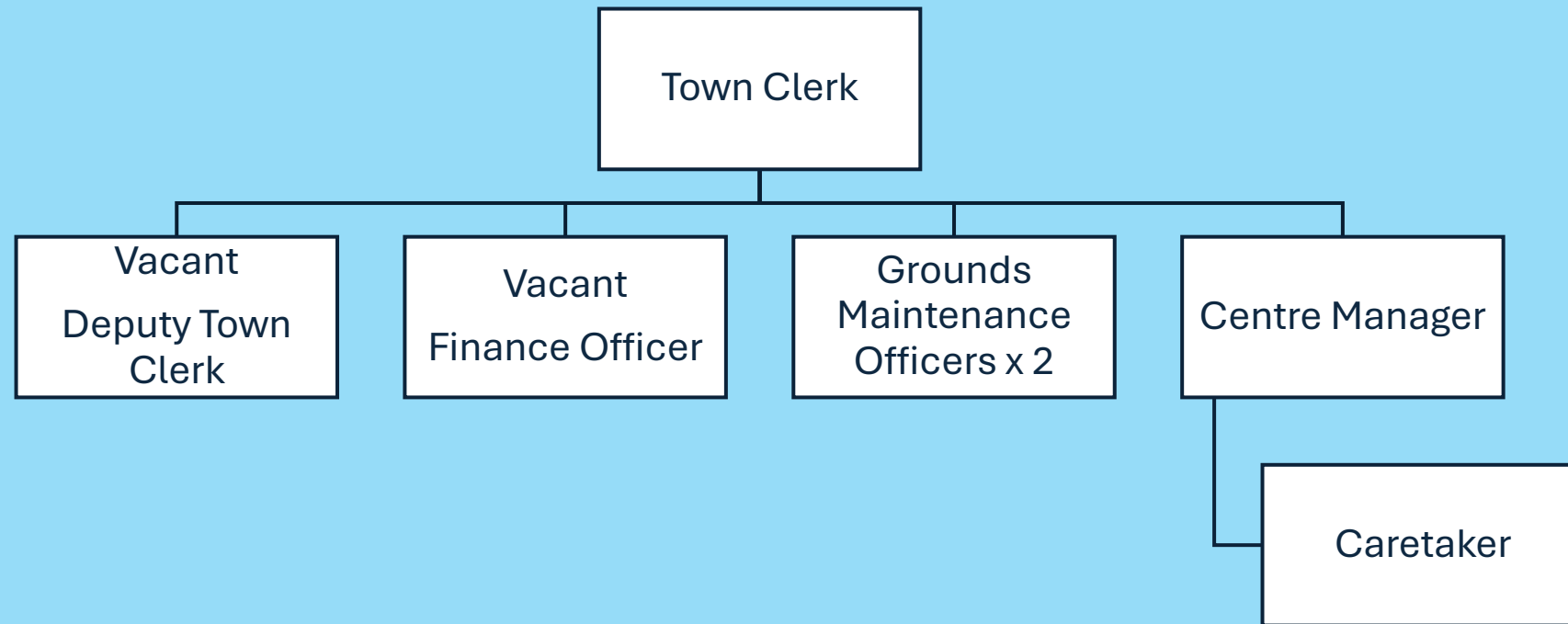

Annual Leave

The post attracts a full-time annual leave entitlement of 23 days per year plus public holidays (pro rata for part time hours) and in addition 2 statutory days are given in December when the office closes.

Pensions

Staff at Bovey Tracey Town Council are eligible to join the Local Government Pension Scheme. The Local Government Pension Scheme (LGPS) is a valuable part of the pay and reward package for employees.

Medical Fitness

The person appointed will be required to complete a confidential medical declaration form and the appointment may be dependent on the issue of a satisfactory report from the organisation's medical adviser if necessary.

Notice to Terminate Employment

The post holder is required to give three months' notice of the termination of their employment. The minimum period of notice to which the post holder is entitled is one month, increasing after four years' service by one week for every subsequent year up to a maximum of 12 weeks.
